Membership Classification

Oakfield is a place to enjoy. We understand the demands put on our members throughout the year, and we ensure this is a place to enjoy and escape from the everyday hustle and bustle. We realize time is precious for today's families and have built our membership offering around you. A breakdown of our membership categories are as follows:

Adult An individual 35 years of age at the start of the calendar year.

Couple Available to any couple 35 years of age or older who are living together at the same residence.

Intermediate Available to any individual from the age of 19-34 at the start of the calendar year.

Collegiate Must be 24 years of age or under at the start of the calendar year and enrolled full-time in college/university. Subject to junior golfer playing restrictions and required to provide proof of enrollment.

Social Golf Pay as you play—\$70 per round, restricted tee sheet access on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays after 12 p.m. Includes 10 rounds of golf.

Sunset Includes unlimited golf after 3:30 p.m. Pay as you play—\$70 per round outside of sunset times. Sunset membership is available to any adult over the age of 25.

Family Available to any individuals 25 years of age or older. A family is consisting of two adults living together at the same residence as social members along with their children as Junior members.

Social No golf privileges (may play as a guest up to 4 times per season with payment of green fee). Unrestricted access to clubhouse for social and business purposes. Invited to all club social functions. Access to Practice Facilities . Access to Oakfield's private beach.

Junior Playing Restrictions (*Applies to all Junior & Collegiate Members*)

Junior members can reserve a tee time 4 days in advance, but are restricted:

- Monday - Thursday anytime excluding league play and group bookings (Collegiate members are permitted to participate in league play within playing restrictions)
- Friday after 3 p.m. Saturday, Sunday and holidays after 12:30 p.m.
- Bantam juniors (age 8-12) must be accompanied by an adult golfer unless with written permission of the Club's professional staff
- Junior members are permitted to play in the Club tournaments if approved by professional staff

Share Purchase Fee - \$100

Applicable to new incoming members Entitles members to vote in the direction the Club moves in.

- This fee is for the purchase of non-equity shares. Each member is required to purchase three non-equity shares priced at \$100 each
- Each couples membership is required to purchase five non-equity shares
- Collegiate and Junior members do not pay for shares until they reach their 25th birthday
- For social (non-golf) memberships, there is no share purchase required



Credit Card Administration Fee

A 3% credit card administration fee is charged for all membership dues paid with credit card. Members are encouraged to pay by cheque, interact or electronic transfer to payments@oakfield.ca.

Member House Account Policy

Oakfield is pleased to provide all members with a charge account as part of their member privileges during the golf season. Members are permitted to charge all purchases they make at the Club to their account. For example: Food & Beverage, Pro-Shop, Carts, and Guest Green Fees etc. It is a **mandatory requirement** of membership that you register a valid credit card with club administration staff which will be held securely on file compliant with Canadian data protection laws. Invoices/statements are issued the first week of each month for the previous month's purchases. Payment of the statement will be processed on the registered credit card on the 20th day of each month, or the first business day thereafter if this date falls on a weekend unless the account has been settled by other means prior to this date (i.e. paid by cheque, cash, debit or email transfer). This provides all members with a minimum of three weeks to check their statement and confirm all charges before payment is processed to their credit card or paid by other means.

Please note: Should payment not be received by the 20th and/or your credit card payment is not authorized, all member privileges will be suspended until such a time as the account is brought up-to-date. 2% interest will apply on any account that is 30 days overdue and is subject to administration fees.

Capital Assessment - \$160 +HST

Applicable to all members of the Club excluding Juniors, Collegiate and Social (non golf). Each member will be invoiced a \$160 assessment on June 1st to assist with Capital Projects throughout the season. Projects that have been completed with these contributions are:

- Driving range improvements
- Clubhouse renovations
- Golf course improvements
- Bunker renovations

*An update on these projects will be available in the quarterly communications to the membership.

Disclaimer: The Club's Board of Directors will decide on Capital Assessment Fees annually and is subject to changes.

Dues Protection Insurance *(optional)*

Dues Protection insurance will be applied if a member is forced to resign or take a leave of absence during the golf season. It covers a partial refund (or credit) of dues depending on the time of year. The Dues Protection covers the following:

- Absence from the region, because of an unexpected change or transfer in employment.
- Illness or physical disability restricting the member from playing golf for the remainder of the season.
- Death

Only members who have purchased the insurance (by May 1st, 2024 and have received acceptance of their resignation or leave of absence request are eligible for a refund or credit under the Dues Protection Program. Dues Protection is an **OPTIONAL** insurance program available to all members. In order for members to receive the insurance you must indicate on the last page of this package that you wish to take the insurance.

All refunds will be done in cheque form and be based on the time of year you activate your insurance. For example if you activate your insurance by May 15, you will receive a 90% credit, 75% by June 15, 50% by July 15 and 26% by August 15.

Refund Schedule: Limited Round Packages

Insurance claims for playing packages are applicable **prior to August 31st only** and cover 75% refund on the remaining number of rounds the member has not redeemed.

Example: 40 round Adult Pack purchased for \$2,700. On July 14th a member is relocated to Toronto through work and needs to cancel his membership having only played 10 times. Once approved, the claim would be processed as follows:

- \$2,700 divided by 40 = \$67.50 per round
- Unused rounds = 30 x \$67.50 = \$2,025
- Insurance Payable x 75% refund
- Total refund = \$1,518.75

Please be reminded Insurance for playing packages covers advanced cancellation of membership only, it does not apply for partially redeemed rounds due to lack of time commitment or other reasons. Claims submitted after September 1st have no redemption value.

Membership Loyalty Program

Oakfield is pleased to provide its members with a complete range of top quality services, and member support is an essential element of making this a success. Unlike many clubs that simply impose a mandatory spending requirement for food and beverage, Oakfield's Loyalty Program also recognizes both golf shop and green fee purchases as part of its program. This provides members with the flexibility to achieve the required amount of spending in a way that best suits their own priorities. All members are required to spend the equivalent of 20% of their annual dues (before tax) on member services. These services include golf shop purchases, food and beverage and guest green fees. A running tally of your member loyalty spend requirement is available through the Member Portal of the website.

Tee Time Bookings

All members have equitable access to tee times throughout the season. Members are permitted to request a tee time up to 7-10 days (subject to lottery setup) in advance, on-line through the member portal.

Full Time Lottery

In order to provide the most equitable tee sheet access to all members, Oakfield operates a lottery style system for tee times. The lottery works on a computer generated algorithm that places all applicants to their specifically requested tee times, then randomly selects individuals to times that have multiple requests. These lotteries open for requests 7-10 days prior to the desired day and closes 4 days prior.



Member/ Guest Rates

Members are encouraged to entertain guests for the posted fees during the following times:

- Monday, Tuesday and Thursday anytime
- Wednesday before 12 p.m. and after 6 p.m.
- Friday after 12:30 p.m.
- Member guests are not permitted to play golf prior to 12:30 p.m. on weekends and holidays
- If a member wishes to bring two or more guests at restricted times, they will need approval from our Professional Staff
