



Golf Course Maintenance

Oakfield Golf and Country Club is an 18 Hole Championship golf course located in Enfield, Nova Scotia. Oakfield GCC was established in 1962 as an inclusive, welcoming and modern country club. The course was originally designed by Robbie Robinson, a Stanley Thompson protégé. The course has since been renovated by Graham Cooke at the turn of the century. Oakfield GCC is a semi private golf club with a large membership, modern lifestyle and a member first approach to service. We are looking for motivated, reliable, self-starting individuals to join our Course Maintenance team. Successful applicants will be responsible for the maintenance and presentation of the golf course on a daily basis, reporting the Superintendent.

Responsibilities include (but not limited to):

- Mowing of greens, tees, fairways, and rough
- Routine maintenance of the bunkers
- Line trimming around trees, signs, etc.
- Shoveling various aggregates (Soil, stone etc.) or digging drainage/irrigation trenches
- General upkeep of course amenities (filling water coolers, emptying garbage receptacles, cleaning course bathrooms etc.)
- Attention to detail (picking up garbage, broken tees, etc.)
- Maintenance of equipment (washing mowers, checking oil levels etc.)

General Requirements:

- Driver's License
- Prior golf course experience preferred (but not necessary)
- Willingness to learn and be trained on equipment
- Ability to work early hours (as early as 5:00am)
- Work every third weekend (mandatory)
- Have reliable transportation to/from work
- Steel Toe Work Boots (mandatory)

- Salary: \$14 to \$18 /hour
